**My Turn to Drive School** is proud to provide Driver's Education instruction to area high school students this fall with classes held at **Middle Bucks Institute of Technology**.

The upcoming theory course, which is approved by the Pennsylvania Department of Education, will consist of 10 classroom sessions of instruction in defensive driving practices and techniques covering various types of driving environments. Additionally, guest speakers such as police officers, lawyers and insurance agents will participate to provide students with a comprehensive understanding of many of the topics they will need to understand as novice drivers. Students can enroll at the age of 15 and above, and your son or daughter **does not need a driving permit** in order to participate in the class. Upon the successful completion of the course, each student will receive a certificate of completion to share with your insurance company.

**The FALL 2018 class at Middle Bucks Institute of Technology begins on Wednesday, September 26<sup>th</sup> from 6pm until 9pm in room 105 and will continue on October 3<sup>rd</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 17<sup>th</sup>, 24<sup>th</sup> November 7<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup>, 28<sup>th</sup> December 5<sup>th</sup> and ending on the 12<sup>th</sup>**

**My Turn to Drive School** specializes in teaching young novice drivers. The school has been operating in the Delaware Valley for over 15 years. All instructors are college graduates, experienced, and fully certified and licensed by the Pennsylvania Department of Education to teach the Defensive Driving highway safety course.

There are three major reasons for offering this defensive driving course. First, the development of the proper attitude toward defensive driving is a most important trait to instill in a young driver. Second, if your teenager successfully completes an accredited driver training course you may save up to 15% on yearly insurance premiums up to 21 years of age. Third, students may be eligible to obtain a senior license at age 17 1/2, instead of age 18, if parental permission is obtained, and all requirements are met.

The fee for the classroom instruction is \$225.00 and includes all classroom materials.
