**My Turn To Drive School** will be offering the PA Department of Education's approved Driver's Education classroom instruction for Radnor High School students this school year. The upcoming theory course will consist of 15 classroom sessions in defensive driving practices and techniques covering various types of driving environments and risk avoidance strategies. Additionally, guest speakers including township police will present. Students can enroll at the age of 15 and above, and your daughter/son does not need a driving permit in order to participate in the class.

**The Fall 2018 class at Radnor H.S. will begin on Tuesday, October 23<sup>rd</sup> after school in room 117 from 3:15pm to 5pm and will continue on: 10/25, 10/30, 11/1, 11/8, 11/13, 11/15, 11/27, 11/29, 12/4, 12/6, 12/11, 12/13, 12/18 and concluding on 12/20**

**The Spring 2019 class at Radnor H.S. will begin on Tuesday, March 26<sup>th</sup> after school in room 117 from 3:15pm to 5pm and will continue on: 3/28, 4/2, 4/4, 4/9, 4/11, 4/23, 4/25, 4/30, 5/2, 5/7, 5/9, 5/14, 5/16 and concluding on 5/23**

**Fall/Winter Saturday morning sessions from 9am until noon are also available at The Haverford School**

**My Turn to Drive School** is a five-star rated driving school specializing in teaching teenage novice drivers. The school has been operating in the Delaware Valley for over 15 years.
