My Turn To Drive School will be offering the PA Department of Education's approved Driver's Education classroom instruction for Lower Merion High School students this school year. The upcoming theory course will consist of 15 classroom sessions in defensive driving practices and techniques covering various types of driving environments and risk avoidance strategies. Additionally, guest speakers including the LM Township Police Department will present. Students can enroll at the age of 15 and above, and your daughter/son does not need a driving permit in order to participate in the class.

The Fall 2019 class at LMHS will begin on Wednesday, September 11th after school in room 332 until 4:15pm and will continue on: 9/12, 9/18, 9/19, 9/25, 9/26, 10/2, 10/3, 10/10, 10/16, 10/17, 10/23, 10/24, 10/29 and concluding on 10/30

The Winter 2020 class at LMHS will begin on Wednesday, January 8th after school in room 332 until 4:15pm and will continue on: 1/9, 1/15, 1/16, 1/22, 1/23, 1/29, 1/30, 2/5, 2/6, 2/12, 2/13, 2/19, 2/20 and concluding on 2/26

Fall/Winter Saturday morning sessions from 9am until noon are available at The Haverford School (see dates below)

My Turn to Drive School is a five-star rated driving school specializing in teaching teenage novice drivers. The school has been operating in Montgomery County for over 15 years. All instructors are college graduates, experienced, and fully certified and licensed by the Pennsylvania Department of Education to teach the Defensive Driving highway safety course.

There are three major reasons for offering this defensive driving course.
