My Turn To Drive School will be offering the PA Department of Education's approved Driver's Education program virtually this year for area high school students. Each session this school year will consist of 15 classes in defensive driving practices and techniques covering various types of driving environments and risk avoidance strategies. Additionally, guest speakers including area police officers, insurance agents and PENNDOT license examiners will present during classes. Students can enroll at the age of 15 and above, and your child does not need a learner's permit in order to participate in the class. Attendance is expected for all classes. Although make up work can be provided for a missed class or two (maximum) if a conflict arises.

The Fall 2023 Zoom class for area high school students will begin on Monday, October 30th from 7pm until 8:30pm and will continue on weeknights until Friday, November 17th.

The Winter 2024 Zoom class for area high school students will begin on Monday, February 12th from 7pm until 8:30pm and will continue on weeknights until Friday, March 1st.

The Spring 2024 Zoom class for area high school students will begin on Monday, May 6th from 7pm until 8:30pm and will continue on weeknights until Friday, May 26th.

My Turn to Drive School is a five-star rated driving school specializing in teaching teenage novice drivers for over 18 years. All instructors are experienced, certified and licensed by the PA Department of Education to teach this Defensive Driving highway safety course. We also provide driving lessons and are certified to administer the driver's license test when your teen is ready.

There are three major reasons for offering this defensive driving course. First, learning about the rules of the road and understanding defensive driving tactics and risk avoidance strategies are the most important aspects of this course. Second, if your teenager successfully completes our accredited driver training course you may save up to 15% on yearly insurance premiums up to 21 years of age. Third, students may be eligible to obtain a senior license at age 17 1/2, instead of age 18, if parental permission is obtained, and all requirements are met.
